

Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



MICHIGAN

Supervisory employees who are present on the premises during hours that alcohol is sold or served must be trained in an approved alcohol server training course. The ServSafe Alcohol™ program **in print form** is approved for use in Michigan and is offered through the Michigan Restaurant Association (MRA). For more information, please contact the MRA at (517) 482-5244, or visit www.michiganrestaurant.org.

Instructors of approved alcohol server training programs must be certified by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC). To teach ServSafe Alcohol in the state of Michigan, you must contact the MRA to become an approved instructor on their roster. The MRA will provide all the necessary documents for you to begin your training and ensure that your classes are in compliance with Michigan's requirements.
